As you know we held no live, in person concerts this season. We made no membership charge and carried forward the membership numbers from the previous season. It is hard to give an accurate figure given that we know we some longstanding members have sadly passed away, but notionally we have about 90 members.

Despite not being able to have live face to face concerts we took the decision to create a Virtual concert series on a YouTube platform. These took place from August through to May. There were 11 in all but split with Showcase. We provided 7 of them.

As indicated earlier, there were no membership fees payable in the season, but we did ask for donations to cover the societies fixed costs such as Public Liability and Piano insurance. Although each artiste who performed in our virtual concert series received a fee the CMS board made the decision to distribute any excess income from donations to the performers who had made recordings for us and had given talks and presentations in the CMS choirs series of Zoom meetings. We are pleased to say that we were able to distribute modest bursaries to 26 musicians. This is in line with our broad charitable aim to further the public appreciation of music; It's hard to appreciate music if all the musicians have gone!

Many thanks to all of you who were able to donate to the Society.

The committee met more frequently in the last season so that we could keep close to the changing covid position and plan for the future.

We have delayed the start of our new season until December and will run through until May. We have been able to secure 3 of the artistes who were scheduled for the

20/21 season and 3 others, some of whom are familiar to you through our virtual concert series. There are some restrictions on numbers at St Marys and we will increase services, such as refreshments as the season progresses and hopefully restrictions reduce.

Thanks to my colleagues on the committee for continuing to work together through the season to plan for the future safely and thanks again to all who were able to donate.
